Subject: pick a topic that you want to research, something that you have discussed or read in class would be most appropriate. Relate the topic back to the subjects that Suzuki is discussing in his book. Water pollution, or air or habitat, species, etc.

Talk to the instructor for confirmation of topic before you start.

Due date: last class **June 2**
Peer review, worth 100 pts.

Format: Poster, no bigger than 24 x 36"
does not have to be rectangular but should not be outside these dimensions. Can be 3 dimensions.

Options: You should include research data, meaning there should be referenced states of fact on the board, including photos, art or some multi-media that supports your topic. color is suggested

Bibliography:
at least 4 sources of information are necessary, typed and taped to the back of the board. no more than 1 shall be internet sources. Use the library, use books, journals, interviews, site visits, etc.
